Metallic Sulfide Mining Facts

- Metallic sulfide mining is the practice of extracting metals (nickel, gold, copper) from a sulfide ore body
- Sulfides exposed to water and air can create sulfuric acid
- Rain/snowwater runoff can cause sulfuric acid to drain into nearby water resources, called acid mine drainage (AMD) causing acidic and uninhabitable living conditions for freshwater life
- AMD acts like a magnet for heavy metals (lead, arsenic, mercury) and can be harmful to human health, plants, animals and metal and concrete structures

Uranium Facts

- Exploration and mining of uranium presents risks to public health
- Disturbance of uranium can increase exposure levels and contaminate drinking water, air and food
- Exposure to uranium and other radioactive materials can cause cancers, kidney disease and reproductive health problems
