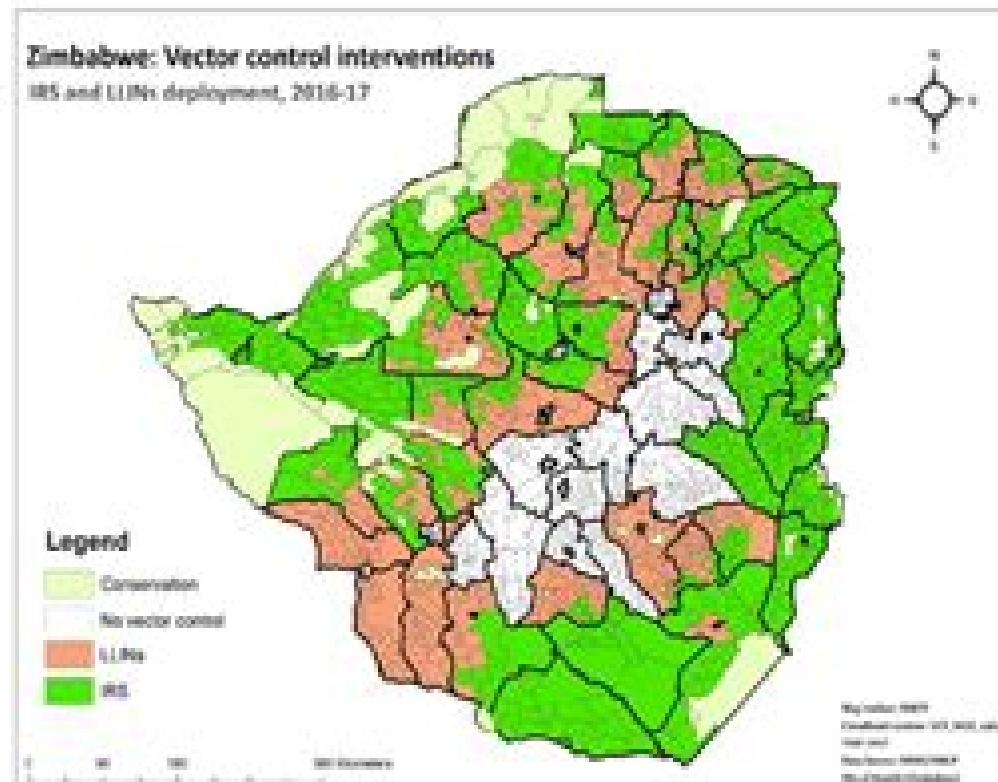

Hickman, 2015-06-04 Malaria takes a great toll on human health and well being particularly in tropical regions including Sub Saharan Africa Southeast Asia Oceania and parts of the Americas In recent years some Plasmodium strains have become increasingly resistant to all classes of conventional antimalarial drugs currently in use Researchers have therefore stepped up efforts to revise atimalarial drug policies develop new drugs and implement new strategies to combat this disease In order to prevent widespread resistance antimalarial combination therapies ACTs have been deployed and a World Antimalarial Resistance Network has been established as a means of anitimalarial drug resistance surveillance Artemisinin based combination therapies have proven to be useful as a replacement for standard regimens Currently these ACTs successfully cure patients suffering from uncomplicated malaria with superior efficacy and lower toxicity but there remains a huge challenge high mortality rate associated with treatment of severe malaria Studies of drug disposition and drug efficacy PK PD evaluations are essential to understanding why drugs work as antimalarials as they illustrate issues with drug resistance drug safety and drug toxicity that are critical to finding the appropriate drug dose for patients This eBook illustrates how currently available combination antimalarial drugs can be optimized for effective malaria treatment Chapters in this book explain methods to select combination drugs based on PK PD evaluations followed by methods o reduce drug toxicity based on these evaluations The book also summarizes efforts that are being made by the research community to improve ACT It is therefore a handy reference for medical professionals and pharmacologists working on antimalarial drugs **Partners**

Malaria Lilly Richardsen, Malaria is one of the world s most enduring and devastating infectious diseases with a history that spans thousands of years It is caused by a parasite from the genus Plasmodium and transmitted to humans through the bite of infected female Anopheles mosquitoes The disease affects millions of people annually with the greatest burden in sub Saharan Africa though it also impacts parts of Asia Latin America and other regions Despite decades of global efforts to control it malaria remains a major public health crisis with significant social economic and health related consequences Historically malaria has been a silent killer often misunderstood and underreported due to its symptoms similarity to those of other illnesses such as flu or viral infections For centuries it was a mystery to scientists and physicians who struggled to understand its causes and transmission It was not until the late 19th century that the true nature of malaria was discovered when scientists like Sir Ronald Ross uncovered the link between mosquitoes and the spread of the disease This discovery laid the foundation for subsequent efforts in prevention and treatment The global burden of malaria is staggering with estimates suggesting that over 200 million cases occur each year resulting in hundreds of thousands of deaths mostly among children under five years old The impact of malaria goes beyond just the number of cases and deaths it also affects economic development Countries heavily burdened by malaria face reduced productivity increased healthcare costs and hindered education as children and adults alike are repeatedly affected by the disease

Multiple first-line therapies as part of the response to antimalarial drug resistance World Health Organization, 2024-11-20 Effective malaria case management requires quick access to diagnostics and antimalarial treatments to reduce illness and death Artemisinin based combination therapy ACT has been essential to malaria treatment since 2001 as it combines artemisinin for rapid parasite reduction with a partner drug to ensure complete cure However resistance to antimalarial drugs where parasites survive standard doses

threatens malaria control Partial resistance to artemisinin linked to Pfk13 mutations has recently emerged in several African countries leading to slower parasite clearance times Artemisinin partial resistance does not lead to ACT failure where the partner medicines are still effective However additional resistance to partner drugs would jeopardize ACT effectiveness To address this threat WHO launched a 2022 strategy to respond to drug resistance in Africa This strategy aims to improve detection enable timely responses and reduce resistance impact through evidence based measures The strategy with 20 approaches includes the measures such as multiple first line therapies MFT to extend the therapeutic useful life of the ACTs This implementation guide providing guidance for malaria programmes by defining MFT reviewing MFT s impact on resistance assessing implications for policy and implementation and identifying evidence gaps for future research *Health and Development* A.
