The story of Cherokee removal to Indian territory their involvement in the American Civil War and the period leading up to Oklahoma statehood in 1907 follows In Part II Native American life through modern times is explored including issues Native people have within American society and with the government Although there are treaties still in full force unless changed by the specific Indian tribe and the U S government many have been abrogated at the government s convenience resulting in numerous lawsuits with some significant settlements in money and rights for the Indian people The government has admitted that terms of treaties have not been upheld and that over the centuries documents were lost or destroyed Some tribes and or their languages and cultures have ceased to exist Yet Native Americans the First Americans continue their fight to gain justice for what has been done to them and taken away from them equality and respect
