Note: Be sure to organize and use subheadings as well as integrate the literature in a way that tells your story.

 - A. Design (Chapters 4, 5, and 6)
 - 1. Will this be a qualitative, quantitative, or mixed? What is your rationale?
 - 2. What type of specific design will be used? What is your rationale?
 - 3. What specific research methods will be used (e.g., control group, comparison group, survey, interviews, etc.)? What is your rationale?
 - B. Sample and Procedures (Chapter 7)
 - Describe your study population and proposed sample (expected size, demographics, etc.)
 - How will the sample be selected? Once they are selected what procedures will they follow as they participate in your study.
