Hull, 2012-04-24 Just as the polls opened on November 5 1872 Susan B Anthony arrived and filled out her ticket for the various candidates But before it could be placed in the ballot box a poll watcher objected claiming her action violated the laws of New York and the state constitution Anthony vehemently protested that as a citizen of the United States and the state of New York she was entitled to vote under the Fourteenth Amendment The poll watchers gave in and allowed Anthony to deposit her ballots Anthony was arrested charged

with a federal crime and tried in court. Primarily represented within document collections and broader accounts of the fight for woman suffrage, Anthony's controversial trial as a landmark narrative in the annals of American law remains a relatively neglected subject. N. E. H.
