When the Meibomian glands may not be producing enough oil.



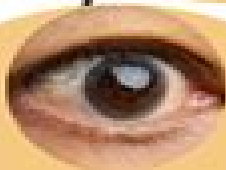
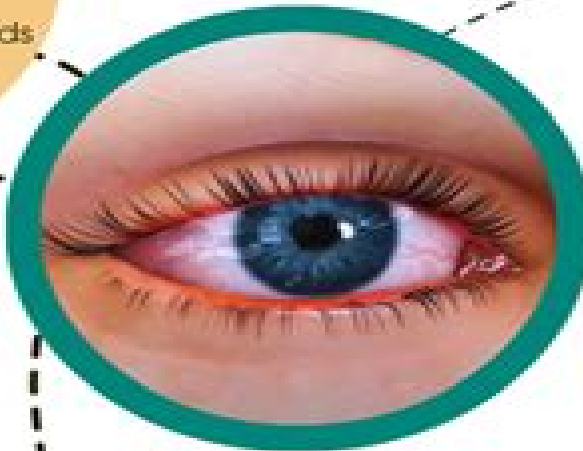
Dry Eye Syndrome

Inflammation of the conjunctiva, commonly referred to as pink eye.



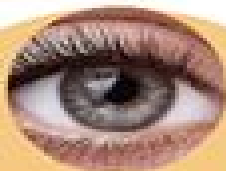
Pinguecula

A yellow-colored growth on the conjunctiva, generally on the side nearest the nose.



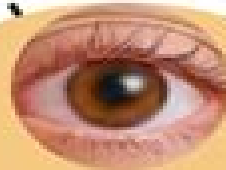
Pterygium
