**Michel Foucault, the State and the Social Sciences** Arnault Skornicki, 2025-09-01 This book proposes an original reading of Foucault's political thought Far from setting aside the question of the State to focus on the relationships of power from below the Foucauldian approach offers a radical anti-substantialist theory of the State Concepts such as biopolitics discipline pastoral power and governmentality serve as tools for understanding the statization of power relations Contrary to some of Foucault's own statements Skornicki highlights the elective affinities between genealogy and sociology which enable an in-depth dialogue with Marxism Max Weber Norbert Elias Edward P Thompson among others Unexpectedly the analytics of power appears thereby as a corrosive and productive science of the State The author meticulously reconstructs drawing on Foucault's extensive body of work how his famous microphysics of power fits into a broader genealogy of the modern State namely the processes of political monopolization that have shaped the so-called Leviathan from the Middle Ages to the present The State thus emerges not as the coldest of all cold monsters nor simply as a vast apparatus of repression but rather as both the product and the agent of multiple governmentalities diverse rationalities and various religious tendencies ranging from the modern rule of law to totalitarianism and neoliberal bureaucracy This is not just a new book about Foucault It is a book about the State and the enduring possibility of theorizing it immersed once more in the caustic waters of genealogy

**Continuum**, 1989. *Interprétations phénoménologiques de la 'Physique' d'Aristote chez Heidegger et Patočka*. Claude Vishnu Spaak, 2018-02-08. Cet ouvrage met en œuvre une confrontation philosophique entre Heidegger et Patočka, deux figures majeures de la tradition phénoménologique en prenant pour fil conducteur leurs interprétations respectives des concepts fondamentaux de la Physique d'Aristote. Mais tout d'abord le point d'accord l'hérméneutique de l'aristotélisme représente aux yeux de Heidegger et de Patočka une première entrée pensante dans l'affaire même de la pensée ou le mouvement irrductible au déplacement d'un tant dans l'espace d'un signe le procès d'advenue au paraître qui sous-tend l'éclosion l'être des choses. Aristote met au jour la différence ontologique entre l'être et l'ayant en sorte que la Physique constitue de ce point de vue pour Heidegger et Patočka le véritable Grundbuch de la philosophie occidentale. Cependant Heidegger et Patočka ne comprennent pas de la même manière le sens de ce mouvement ontologique au cœur de l'être travers l'examen de ces différences l'enjeu de cet ouvrage est de mettre en évidence un point de tension au sein de la phénoménologie qui n'a pas encore suffisamment été remarqué d'une part l'approche heideggerienne qui soumet l'être au sens et s'expose de la sorte au risque d'un anthropocentrisme ontologique larvé. Et d'autre part la tentative d'un réalisme phénoménologique dont Patočka fut l'un des représentants dans la double mesure où il brise l'identité classique de l'être et de l'intelligibilité et où il pense l'homme comme radicalement décentré prôtendant en finir ainsi avec le sujet et tous ses avatars c'est le sens de la fameuse phénoménologie asubjective réalisme radical dont on peut toutefois se demander s'il ne met pas mal le paradigme phénoménologique de l'a priori de la corrélation entre l'apparaître et ses modes subjectifs de donné et s'il ne remet pas en cause ainsi la possibilité même de la phénoménologie en la poussant au-delà de sa propre limite. *Glyph*, 1980. Les philosophes de l'expérience radicale soutiennent en effet qu'il existe une différence de nature entre deux grands types d'expériences : d'un côté les expériences pratiques habituelles, empiriques, qui

*Glyph Seven* Samuel Weber, 1980-06 [Voluntary Servitude and the Erotics of Friendship](#) Marc D. Schachter, 2016-12-05 Focusing primarily on three early modern French authors this book explores the erotics and politics of voluntary servitude in classical antiquity and the early modern period These authors include La Boétie Michel de Montaigne and Marie de Gournay pursue related inquiries into voluntary servitude and self control in marriage friendship pederasty and politics Marc Schachter shows how Montaigne's intimate textual relationship with La Boétie provides him the opportunity to honor his beloved friend while transforming many of his ideas Similarly Marie de Gournay's editorial voluntary servitude to Montaigne provides her the occasion to authorize her own practice as a woman author and to engage critically with Montaigne's ideas even as she celebrates her friendship with him Schachter's analyses are pursued particularly through the lens of Michel Foucault's concept of governmentality which like voluntary servitude operates on three interrelated scales self control control in interpersonal relationships and political control Schachter argues that thinking about the function of voluntary servitude through the lens of governmentality leads to a more nuanced understanding both of Foucault's late work and of the transformational possibilities offered by friendship and voluntary servitude in early modern France

*Les dessous des tendances* Julien Féré, 2022-06-14 Les tendances en apparence insignifiantes occupent des pans entiers de notre société l'industrie de la mode du cosmétique et plus globalement de l'apparence bien sûr mais aussi les grands mouvements sociaux comme l'écologie la question du genre ou celle de l'identité Elles sont la fois réservées aux spécialistes les journalistes les tendanceurs les trend setters les cabinets de style les stars et en même temps chacun peut se les approprier voire les lancer Et elles semblent agir dans l'ombre sans qu'on sache vraiment où elles vont s'exprimer tout en tant largement commentées et codées par les médias qui se posent en passeurs Derrière ces imaginaires circulants qui rendent la notion de tendance en permanence paradoxale importante insignifiante visible invisible spécialiste grand public futile utile cet ouvrage répond deux questions simples comment crée-t-on une tendance et comment

celle-ci se diffuse-t-elle ? Pour cela, il convoque la sémiotique et la théorie du signe ainsi que les sciences de l'information et de la communication pour étudier la circulation des discours dans la société. Une plongée dans l'histoire et la théorie des tendances au travers d'une recherche universitaire et d'invités qui manipulent ces tendances : journalistes, publicitaires, influenceurs, marketeurs, chercheurs, etc. et livrent leur témoignage avec une conclusion fondamentale : derrière son imaginaire, vanescent la tendance est un principe de construction de nos vies contemporaines qui joue un rôle important dans la construction de l'individualité, dans le sentiment d'appartenance à un groupe et dans l'impression de faire partie de la société.

L' Origine à venir François Ansermet, 2023-01-18. On ne dit pas tout de ce que l'on devient. Une clinique de l'origine est distinguer d'une clinique du devenir. Ce livre met en tension origine et devenir, un devenir qui peut s'inventer tout au long de la vie au-delà des pièges du destin. L'origine n'est pas un destin. Elle se prend dans le tourbillon d'un devenir qui ne peut être ramenée aux seules conditions d'origine, ce qu'on peut décliner dans le champ de la procréation, de l'adoption, de la prédiction jusqu'aux origines recrées dans les transitions de genre, toutes sortes de situations qui impliquent un au-delà de ce qui semblait déterminé ou prédictible. Plutôt qu'une origine déterminante, ce livre ouvre sur cette origine en devenir, venir où tout n'est pas joué. Chacun peut se faire l'auteur et l'acteur des surprises d'un devenir qui se joue en fonction de ses choix, chacun son devenir au-delà de toute détermination. D'où l'enjeu de la psychanalyse d'être aussi une pratique de l'imprévisible.

*L'adolescent dans la foule* Claudia Bouliane, 2018-10-16. Depuis Mai 68, on a l'habitude de voir des jeunes gens rallier une foule, former une foule, mais cela n'a pas toujours été le cas. Les grands mouvements politiques des années 1920 et 1930 ont amené diverses personnes se joindre des rassemblements urbains, dont une catégorie de la population nouvellement prise en compte : les adolescents. Leur introduction dans les masses humaines a généré plusieurs récits tout au long de l'entre-deux-guerres. Ce sont ces récits qu'étudie ce livre, lequel tente de comprendre pourquoi l'association de la foule et de l'adolescent figure avec autant de force dans plusieurs textes littéraires de la première moitié du XX<sup>e</sup> siècle. Par le biais de lectures sociocritiques des *Beaux quartiers* de Louis Aragon (1936), *La conspiration* de Paul Nizan (1938) et *du Sursis* de Jean-Paul Sartre (1945), il montre comment ce motif particulier permet de révéler des tensions qui traversent l'imaginaire social. L'étude convoque en appui la démonstration, nombre de fictions : *Les Thibault*, *Mort crève*, *dit Les hommes de bonne volonté*, *La chronique des Pasquier*, etc. qui entrent en rapport avec ces trois œuvres. Toutes ces publications littéraires sont lues en interaction avec un ensemble composé de textes médicaux, politiques, religieux et urbanistiques.

Machines intimes : de Baudelaire à Barthes (en passant par Proust et Bataille) Tomasz Swoboda, 2025-09-01 Le retour spectaculaire du refoulé est l'un des déterminants du rythme particulier de la modernité La machine y a aussi sa part Quand les désirs et les peurs liés à la machine abandonnés silencieux cachés derrière le voile du progrès émergent ils créent une sorte de phénoménologie de la machine qui pendant de nombreuses décennies constitue un point de référence pour des activités littéraires et artistiques La machine s'y trouve pour ainsi dire intrinsèquement liée aux affects et aux désirs elle devient ce que je me propose d'appeler machine intime Ce processus est étudié ici travers les œuvres de Baudelaire Proust Bataille Barthes et quelques autres dont Roussel Artaud Didi Huberman ainsi que dans la littérature rotique contemporaine The spectacular return of the repressed is one of the determinants of the particular rhythm of modernity The machine also plays its part When the desires and fears linked to the machine abandoned silent hidden behind the veil of progress emerge they create a kind of phenomenology of the machine which for many decades constituted a point

of reference for literary and artistic activities The machine is so to speak interiorised inextricably linked to affects and desires it becomes what I propose to call an intimate machine This process is explored here through the works of Baudelaire Proust Bataille Barthes and others including Roussel Artaud and Didi Huberman as well as in contemporary erotic literature

*D'une Bretagne à l'autre* Bernard Merdrignac, 2012 Durant tout le Moyen ge les lettrés n'ont cessé de puiser dans un fond historico-légendaire commun la Bretagne et la Grande Bretagne Entre les lignes des Vies de saints récrites d'un siècle à l'autre se décelent le système de représentations des laïques dont les hagiographes reprennent des éléments afin de les recharger de sens au service de leurs commanditaires et pour la gouverne de leurs destinataires En brossant le portrait des saints fondateurs de la chrétienté bretonne les clercs médiévaux qui monopolisaient alors l'écriture se sont acharnés délibérément ou non à occulter ce qu'il est convenu d'appeler la première migration bretonne organisée militairement par l'Empire romain III<sup>e</sup> Ve siècle L'historicité des bribes de légendes recyclées dans les sources hagiographiques est sujette à caution Bernard Merdrignac s'emploie recouper ces données avec d'autres indices obtenus indépendamment grâce aux méthodes spécifiques d'autres disciplines archéologie épigraphie toponymie géologie etc Il propose ainsi des hypothèses hardies quoique solidement étayées sur cette période moins connue du très haut Moyen ge La liberté d'écriture de cet essai historique ravivera les amateurs d'histoire pour qui la rigueur de la recherche ne va pas forcément de pair avec une fastidieuse cuistrerie dans l'exposé de ses résultats Faber suae fortunae Lilia Coropceanu, 2010 Ayant comme point de départ la corrélation étroite entre les domaines de la subjectivité de l'historicité et de la littérature Faber Suae Fortunae se donne pour objectif d'analyser les particularités distinctives du processus de l'autoformation du sujet partir d'un corpus de textes littéraires de la fin du dix-septième siècle jusqu'au début du dix-neuvième siècle La lecture des romans de Mme de Lafayette de Marivaux et de Stendhal révèle par conséquent des modes distincts de subjectivation c'est-à-dire différents modes de dire que les personnages choisissent en vue de faire œuvre de soi de se constituer comme sujets éthiques En suivant cette piste on pourrait ajouter la définition existante de la notion du moi selon laquelle le moi désigne le sujet en tant qu'il se pense lui-même un composant conceptuel supplémentaire le sujet en tant qu'il se forme lui-même qu'il s'engage dans une pratique d'autoformation
