RED-FOOTED BOOBY: This small sulid occurs only very rarely in North American waters but shows up about every other year at the Dry Tortugas. Records away from there number very few. It is distinct from the others in several respects: it is more pelagic, it is the only polymorphic sulid, and it is the only one that nests in bushes or trees. Red-footed feeds over deep water, at times with other pelagic species, taking mostly flying fish and squid. It dives vertically from lower elevations (about thirty feet) and usually roosts in trees. Red-footed regularly lands on and rides in boats, and its relatively slender build suits its more pelagic habits, allowing for a more agile and buoyant flight than that of the others. Note also the smaller, more slender bill and notably rounder head with a steeper forehead, which combine to give this species a unique expression. Being polymorphic, Red-footed Booby is highly variable in adult plumage, with some appearing almost entirely brown (similar to immature

Brown Booby) and others appearing mostly bright white with black primaries and secondaries (similar to Masked Booby). Many found in the United States are brown birds (and often immatures), but both white and brown morphs are possible and have occurred on both coasts." 10 Adults (both light and brown morphs) from the Caribbean show white tails, but those in the Pacific vary, having brown or white tails. Florida records are mainly immatures, and those birds are usually entirely brown. Occasionally immature (apparent secondcycle) Red-footeds show dappled upperparts. Adults have bright red feet, bluish-gray bills, and pinkish facial skin. Confusion is most likely with immature Brown Booby, but note the difference in head shape, body proportions, and chest and underwing patterns. Compared to Brown Booby, Red-footed has more slender and more pointed wings, and brown-plumaged Red-footeds are also wholly dark on the underwings. Most juvenile Brown Boobies show a shadow pattern



Breeding adult white-morph Red-footed Booby, Hi, Mar (BH). Red-footed Booby has the most colorful facial skin of any of the sulids, and it is the only species that is polymorphic, occurring in brown and white morphs. There is variation even among brown and white morphs, however, with Caribbean birds being white tailed, and eastern Pacific birds being both light and dark, though most are dark tailed. Note Red-footed Booby's more delicate build, lighter bill, and steeper forehead.
