Freud's theory can be read as a defensive myth that patients themselves invent in order to avoid confronting a forbidden enjoyment. Lacan's theory sheds a new light on this need for a defense. Seen from that angle, the whole history of psychoanalysis, its twists and turns, is revisited, revealing connections with recent discoveries in attachment theory.
