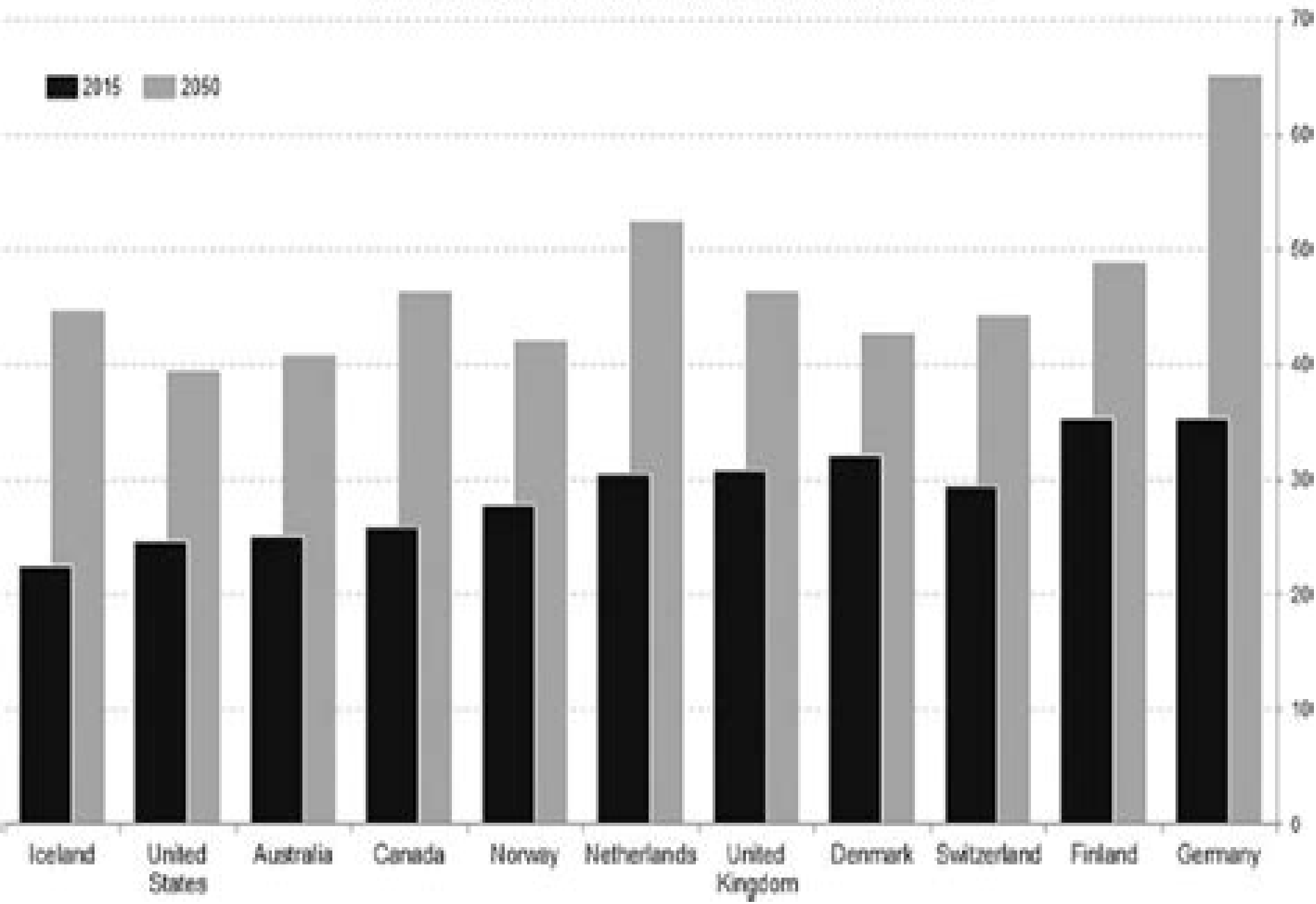


Old-age dependency ratios (%)
