The National Children's Study 2014 National Research Council, Institute of Medicine, Board on Children, Youth, and Families, Division of Behavioral and Social Sciences and Education, Committee on National Statistics, Panel on the Design of the National Children's Study and Implications for the Generalizability of Results, 2014-08-26

The National Children's Study (NCS) was authorized by the Children's Health Act of 2000 and is being implemented by a dedicated Program Office in the Eunice Kennedy Shriver National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD). The NCS is planned to be a longitudinal observational birth cohort study to evaluate the effects of chronic and intermittent exposures on child health and development in the U.S. The NCS would be the first study to collect a broad range of environmental exposure measures for a national probability sample of about 100,000 children followed from birth or before birth to age 21. Detailed plans for the NCS were developed by 2007 and reviewed by a National Research Council Institute of Medicine panel. At that time, sample recruitment for the NCS Main Study was scheduled to begin in 2009 and to be completed within about 5 years. However, results from the initial seven pilot locations which recruited sample cases in 2009-2010 indicated that the proposed household-based recruitment approach would be more costly and time-consuming than planned. In response, the Program Office implemented a number of pilot tests in 2011 to evaluate alternative recruitment methods and pilot testing continues to date. At the request of Congress, The National Children's Study 2014 reviews the revised study design and proposed methodologies for the NCS Main Study. This report assesses the study's plan to determine whether it is likely to produce scientifically sound results that are generalizable to the United States population and appropriate subpopulations. The report makes recommendations about the overall study framework, sample design, timing, content, and need for scientific expertise and oversight. The National Children's Study has the potential to add immeasurably to scientific knowledge about the impact of environmental exposures broadly defined on children's health and development in the United States. The recommendations of this report will help the NCS achieve its intended objective to examine the effects of environmental influences on the health and development of American children.

Posthuman Bliss? Susan B. Levin, 2020-12-03

challenge to transhumanists claim that science and technology support their vision of posthumanity In a clear and engaging style she dismantles transhumanists breezy assurances that posthumans will emerge if we but allocate sufficient resources to that end Far from offering theoretical and practical proof of concept for the vision that they urge upon us Levin argues transhumanists engage inadequately with cognitive psychology biology and neuroscience often relying on questionable or outdated views within those fields Having shown in depth why transhumanism should be rejected Levin argues forcefully for a holistic perspective on living well that is rooted in Aristotle's virtue ethics but that is adapted to liberal democracy This holism is thoroughly human in the best of senses It directs us to consider worthy ends for us as human beings and to do the irreplaceable work of understanding ourselves rather than relying on technology and science to be our salvation

High-Level Adaptation and Aftereffects Rocco Palumbo, Stefania D'Ascenzo, Luca Tommasi, 2017-04-28 Aftereffects generally occur after a prolonged exposure to a first stimulus possessing one given property, followed by presentation of a stimulus bearing a neutral value of that property. The aftereffect consists in a change in appearance of the neutral stimulus following the adapter, compared to the appearance of the neutral stimulus when it is perceived without any previous exposure to the adapter. The transient phenomena of perceptual aftereffects are believed to depend on the activation of neuron populations that respond selectively to a given property of the stimuli. Studying how adaptation occurs, which stimulus properties are sensitive to it, which timings are necessary, whether individual differences modulate its occurrence, has thus become an indirect way to probe the plasticity of sensory functions in the nervous system, recently extending to more cognitive and representational aspects of neural coding. In the last two decades, indeed, it has been demonstrated that aftereffects occur not only for low-level properties of stimuli, such as motion, color, or orientation, but also for high-level properties. Many studies have proven that high-level properties of the stimuli, e.g., gender, identity, ethnicity, or age of a face, or a voice, are sensitive to this phenomenon. It has been shown, for example, that the prolonged exposure to a female or male face produces a gender misperception in the opposite direction when an androgynous face is shown after the adapter. Furthermore, recent studies have also shown that aftereffects are not strictly contingent upon the physical features that make up stimuli, but they seem to run across the high-level properties subjects are adapted to. These evidences are supported by cross-category adaptation studies, which underlie how aftereffects occur even across stimuli that do not share physical features, e.g., bodies and faces, but that instead share common higher-level properties, such as gender. Given the

growing body of research focused on adaptation and aftereffects in high level perception at the boundaries with perceptual learning attention and cognition the purpose of this topic is to provide a picture of the state of the art relative to the specific phenomena of adaptation in high level perceptual processing

On the one hand, research has shown that explicit criteria may positively affect student performance, reduce their anxiety, as well as support students' use of self-regulated learning strategies. On the other hand, there are fears that explicit criteria may have a restraining influence on students' learning, as well as limiting their autonomy and creativity. There are also indications of students becoming more performance-oriented as opposed to learning-oriented when being provided with explicit assessment criteria. Taken together, it is not fully understood under which circumstances it is productive for student learning to share explicit assessment criteria, and under which circumstances it is not. In particular, empirical research on the proposed negative effects of sharing criteria with learners is limited, and most fears voiced in the literature are based on individual experiences and anecdotal evidence. In this book, we therefore bring different perspectives on transparency in assessment together in order to further our understanding of how students are influenced by the use of explicit assessment criteria. A deeper understanding of the influence of explicit assessment criteria on students' understanding of criteria, motivation, and learning is equally imperative for future research and educational practice, both of which need to go beyond individual opinions and convictions.

Categoriality and continuity in prosodic prominence

Simon Roessig, 2020-09-08 Prosody has been characterised as a half-tamed savage, being shaped by both discrete categorical aspects as well as gradient continuous phenomena.
