

the question of knowledge production in such a diverse social landscape We discuss the impact of current trends in information technology and contemporary forms of identity and mobility on knowledge production These issues are pertinent for different sectors such as academia government or business and as we demonstrate reveal a myriad of possibilities for studying diverse population groups like youth women diaspora or specific political contexts such as conflict or oppression
