She goes on to mention she tries to keep herself busy of an evening, otherwise she will miss her husband, this is an intrusion of grief within the (LO) process.

She mentions she had to sign 'widow' on a form, and she felt hurt, this was another intrusion of grief, but she was also in the (RO) process as she was using her new identity.

She mentions she went to the cinema with a friend, had a lovely time and really laughed so was in the (RO) process, but she felt guilty for having a good time. So she had dipped back into the (LO) process.

She also mentions how they always used to go to a club with a group of friends, and how they have invited her, but she says how they all have partners and she would stick out like a sore thumb. She is in the (LO) process here as she is allowing intrusion of grief and avoiding restoration.

She said about how angry she feels at times, and how she hates her self at times. She ends this with 'I'm horrible aren't I?' its as if she seeks clarification from the person she is talking too. She does this on several occasions, 'of course you have to go on for the children, don't you?', 'stupid isn't it?'. 'but you cant, can you?'. This is not only confusion as Maggie suddenly has had her whole world turned upside down. She's suddenly now alone, new identity, new job roles etc, all part of the grieving process I believe. It makes her question herself, everything she does, her actions etc?
