Towards an Institutional Theory of Community and Community Associations Carl Milofsky, 2019-08-26 This article argues the position that the symbolic sense of community is a product of action by associations and larger community based organizations It draws on a theory from urban sociology called the community of limited liability In the past this theory first articulated by Morris Janowitz has mostly been used to argue that residents living in a local neighborhood feel a sense of identification with that area to the extent that the symbolism of that neighborhood has been developed This article extends Janowitz's theory to apply to local associations and their efforts to create activities movements and products that encourage residents to expand their sense of symbolic attachment to a place We argue that this organizational method has long been used by local associations but it has not been recognized as an organizational theory Because associations have used this approach over time communities have a historical legacy of organizing and symbol creating efforts by many local associations Over time they have competed collaborated and together developed a collective vision of place They also have created a local interorganizational field and this field of interacting associations and organizations is dense with what we call associational social capital Not all communities have this history of associational activity and associational social capital Where it does exist the field becomes an institutionalized feature of the community This is what we mean by an institutional theory of community Nonprofit Organization Governance Stijn Van Puyvelde, 2016-08-29 Organizational governance has become a popular and important topic in third sector research This review focuses on the governance of paid staff nonprofit organizations also called nonprofit agencies which are characterized by a hierarchical structure where the board has the power and the responsibility to ensure that governance functions are carried out In this review Van Puyvelde discusses previous literature on nonprofit organization governance Next a wide array of theoretical perspectives are presented that may be useful when studying the governance of nonprofit organizations In order to analyze a number of important contemporary governance challenges some of these theories are integrated by using a paradox perspective The underlying

idea is that depending upon the governance challenge under consideration a different combination of theoretical perspectives may be required Van Puyvelde concludes that different theoretical frameworks can co exist in the literature each addressing a different issue in nonprofit governance

The French Nonprofit Sector Laura Nirello,Lionel Prouteau,2018-08-20 This article deals with the literature on the French nonprofit sector NPS A preliminary part is devoted to presenting and discussing the characteristics that shape the approaches to this sector in France We stress the strong influence of legal categories on the sector s definition and in this context the importance of the status inherited from the 1901 Act on contracts of association This raises a problem for a more analytical approach to the sector because the diversity of the nonprofit organizations NPOs regulated under this Act risks being overshadowed In this first part we also underline the primacy accorded in France to the concept of the social economy which has today become the social and solidarity economy SSE over that of the nonprofit sector In the second part the article outlines some landmarks in the history of the French NPS French NPOs were for many years objects of suspicion arbitrariness and repression on the part of the public authorities and this persisted until the 1901 legislation on contracts of association was enacted However this hostile context did not prevent the sector from having a richer existence than is sometimes admitted This literature review also focuses on empirical studies of the sector placing a particular emphasis on the more recent ones These French studies basically adopt two types of approach The first is concerned essentially with the NPOs and focuses its attention on their economic importance whether measured in terms of financial resources employment or less frequently added value The second approach investigates the kinds of individual participation the sector engenders by examining the various forms it takes such as membership of NPOs or voluntary work This review ends with the analysis of the challenges that NPS faces in a context characterized by the increasing constraints on public funding changes in the nature of such funding with a substitution of contracts for subsidies an increased competition among NPOs as well as between NPOs and for profit enterprises The article concludes that despite the advances in research on the French NPS some aspects like formal volunteering and the role of voluntary associations are still understudied while others like informal groups and informal volunteering are almost totally ignored

The State of Nonprofit Sector Research in Japan Aya Okada,Yu Ishida,Takako Nakajima,Yasuhiko Kotagiri,2017-11-06 Despite a long history the organized field of research on voluntaristics in Japan has emerged only in the past two decades This article presents a comprehensive review of voluntaristics research in Japan through an overview of past studies and recent hot topics Nonprofit sector and voluntary action research now termed voluntaristics Smith 2016 is reviewed here using four approaches organizational economic employment and charitable giving Discussion of recent changes in the political legal environment for nonprofit agencies and associations as well as of collaboration among nonprofits governments and businesses are presented The article also covers some of the key topics in recent years including rising social movements and advocacy social impact bonds social capital and information and communication technologies

ICT and social media In discussing the emergence expansion and diversification of nonprofit research in Japan the article makes two main arguments First we argue that studies of voluntaristics are rather recent in Japan still in pursuit of their own originality Second we argue that nonprofit research in Japan is constantly looking for an ideal relationship with practice Research appears to have not fully caught up with the changing landscape of nonprofits in action and research has not been able to guide practice into the best next steps The article highlights characteristics of nonprofit sector research in Japan as well as suggesting key questions for future research

Review and Assessment of China's Nonprofit Sector after Mao David Horton Smith, 2016-11-21 Published research in English is reviewed on the Nonprofit Sector NPS in mainland China since Mao's death in 1976 A large diverse and rapidly growing NPS exists but openly political Nonprofit Organizations NPOs outside the Communist Party and its control are prohibited China has civil society in the narrower sense a substantial civil society sector or NPS exists However the party state in China continues to play a dominating role in regard to the NPS especially for registered NPOs Freedom of association is still limited in China especially for national associations which are nearly all Government Organized Nongovernmental Organizations GONGOs not genuine NGOs NPOs The broader scope definition of civil society focuses on functioning civil liberties and the ability of NPOs in general to influence significantly the government on various policy issues In these terms China has a weak but slowly emerging civil society with far more associational freedom than under Mao

Organizational Imaginaries Katherine K. Self-Help/Mutual Aid Groups and Peer Support Thomasina Borkman, 2021-01-04 Thomasina Borkman reviews English language social science research on North American self help mutual aid groups SHGs and organizations and some from industrialized countries SHGs known by many names are voluntary member run groups of peers who share a common issue utilize lived experience and practice mutual aid Borkman's autoethnographic approach highlights her international SHG participation Despite initial common values and practices in the 1960s and on Alcoholics Anonymous the mental health SHGs and other SHGs evolved in the US as three separate social movements that became institutionalized by 2000 their history characteristics achievements and supportive infrastructure are summarized British contributors Munn Giddings and Boyce show in European countries how socio political contexts shape self help mutual aid Research has shifted from SHGs to peer support since 2000

The Evolution of the Israeli Third Sector Rachel Calipha, Benjamin Gidron, 2021-03-15 The Evolution of the Israeli Third Sector reviews the development of the nonprofit sector in Israel and analyzes it within existing nonprofit theories It takes a historical perspective in looking at its evolution in light of political social ideological and economic changes in the world and in the country It discusses the development of policy and government involvement on the one hand and the unique features of Israeli philanthropy both Jewish and Arab on the other It

analyzes Israel's civil society and social movements as well as social entrepreneurship and their expression in the Third Sector. The book also covers the development of research and education on the Third Sector; it includes a review of research centers, databases, journals, and specific programs that were developed by Israeli universities.

A Review of Third Sector Research in Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand: 1990-2016 Jenny Onyx, Garth Nowland-Foreman, 2017-11-06 This is the first comprehensive overview of third sector research in Australasia prepared by leading researchers Jenny Onyx in Australia and Garth Nowland-Foreman in Aotearoa New Zealand. Philanthropy in Contemporary Africa Jacob Mwathi Mati, 2017-01-23 Despite the availability of a wide range of literature on what can be construed to be philanthropic behaviour in Africa, there is limited conceptual discussion on what constitutes philanthropy in African contexts. Yet philanthropic behaviour is a culturally rooted phenomenon manifesting in diverse forms, expressions, and models. This review contributes to a growing body of literature on conceptions and manifestations of African philanthropy. The review illustrates a complex plurality of actions that fall under cultures and practices of giving in Africa. These include the giving of money, time, knowledge, influence, and visibility in support of a cause; valuable goods and body parts/organs from living and dead. While some of these actions conform to dominant Western notions of philanthropy, others do not. From an analysis of these practices, this paper proposes that African philanthropy can be conceptually structured on the basis of spheres of philanthropic practice and the underlying bases and motivations for philanthropy. On spheres of philanthropic practice, at least three forms of philanthropy exist: institutional, formal, non-institutional, non-formal, informal, direct, and a hybrid form that blends practices from the formal and informal spheres. On motivations for giving, the predominant forms are based on mutuality, solidarity, and counter obligation inherent in collectivist and humanistic African philosophies of life. Further motivations are drawn from religious obligations, institutional requirements on corporate bodies, and institutional arrangements in the development process. There are nonetheless significant overlaps between spheres of practice and motivations in contemporary philanthropic practices in Africa. For instance, philanthropic culture in Africa manifests as religious giving, donations to individuals or institutions, mutual aid, reciprocal self-help, revolving fund organisations, corporate social responsibility activities, and individual family donations to public benefit organisations. These practices highlight a rich tapestry of spheres of practice and motivations for giving practices where the wealthy and the poor are equally involved. The

review concentrates by choice on giving of money and time volunteering especially informal volunteering due to dearth of academic literature on other forms of giving as philanthropy in Africa

Determinants of Individual Prosociality and of Collective Social Solidarity- Cohesion David Horton Smith, 2019-08-26 The foundations of volunteering charitable giving voluntary associations voluntary agencies and other aspects of the Voluntary Nonprofit Sector VNPS collectively and of individual voluntary action lie in various aspects of human nature and societies These foundations may be referred to variously as altruism morality ethics virtue kindness generosity cooperation social solidarity and prosociality eusociality These foundations of the VNPS and specifically of social solidarity and prosociality are the subjects of this literature review article book The central goal is providing a comprehensive and interdisciplinary theoretical framework for understanding explaining and predicting such phenomena based on two versions of the author's S Theory 1 Individual System Level General S Theory of Human Behavior as presented briefly here and in greater detail elsewhere Smith 2015 2020a 2020b Smith 2 Social System Level General S Theory of Collective Prosociality Social Solidarity as partially sketched here for the first time in print Social System Level General S Theory of collective Prosociality Social Solidarity argues that collective social solidarity can be better explained with a broader than usual range of factors as major causal influences beyond normative systems Individual prosociality behavior can be best explained and understood using the author's Individual System Level General S Theory of Human Behavior Prosociality includes a instrumental task oriented helping behavior such as formal and informal volunteering or charitable giving for non household non immediate family persons and also informal care of residential household immediate family persons plus b expressive prosociality or sociability that involves positive interpersonal relations with one or more other persons both in the residential household immediate family or outside of it based on feelings of attachment fellowship friendship affection and or love Prosociality and social solidarity are clearly human universals as Brown 1991 concludes from anthropological studies on hundreds of mostly preliterate societies on all continents Such individual human prosociality activities often have positive short and long term consequences for the people who do them

A Survey of Voluntaristics David Horton Smith, 2015-11-24 This article provides a survey of the growth of research on Nonprofit Sector and Voluntary Action Research now termed simply voluntaristics The author founded the organized global interdisciplinary socio behavioral science field of voluntaristics in 1971 with his formation and establishment of the Association for Research on Nonprofit Organizations and Voluntary Action ARNOVA www.arnova.org Both ARNOVA and its interdisciplinary academic journal Nonprofit and Voluntary Sector Quarterly NVSQ have served as initial models for the global diffusion of this interdisciplinary field now present in all inhabited continents and with upwards of 20 000 academic participants in at least 130 nations and territories and likely more Voluntaristics after more than 40 years of growth now qualifies as a new global integrative academic discipline in the socio behavioral sciences and related social professions not just as one of many interdisciplinary fields of research according to six defining criteria for a discipline However the author prefers to label voluntaristics as an inter discipline since its hallmark is the interdisciplinary study of all voluntary nonprofit sector VNPS phenomena
