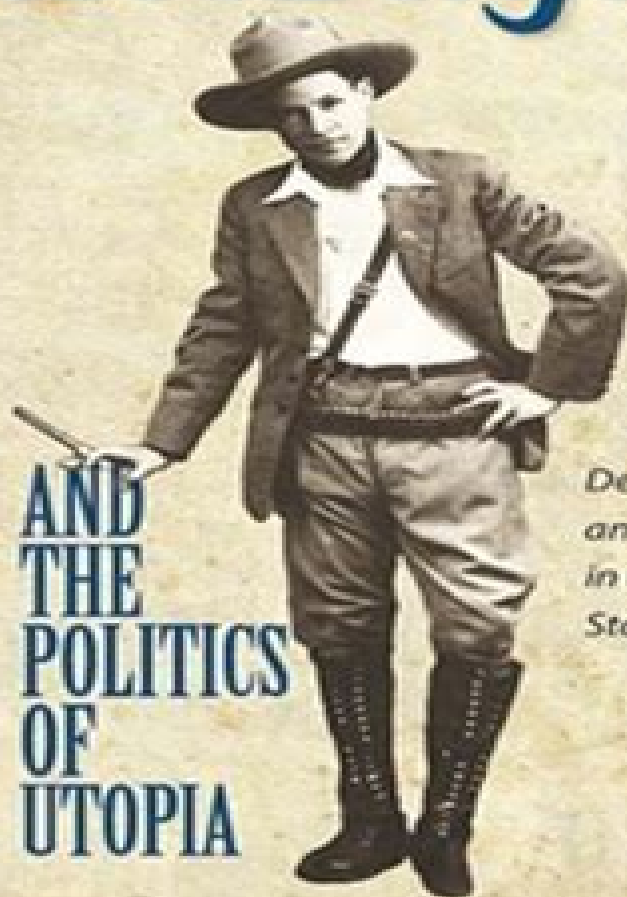

In every case, Chavez shows the reflective nature of cultural production and its pursuit of utopian idealism.
