Plato s dialog Ion In that Plato through the caricature of Socrates explains that inspiration is like a magnet and that once it touches a ring of iron the ring becomes magnetic as well I believe that God through the course of living events touches some of us When some particularly the Apostles and Prophets are in their closest communication with God their thoughts become divine When those thoughts come out on ink and paper that ink and paper becomes in a sense embedded with divine thoughts To borrow an analogy from another great thinker it is like a map of a great idea.
