involvement with groups devoted to feeding school children and expanding Bible study sessions seemed benign these white women s growing awareness of racial disparities in Memphis and elsewhere caused them to question the South s hierarchies in ways many of their peers did not Ultimately they found themselves challenging segregation more directly found themselves ostracized as a result and discovered they were often distrusted by a justifiably suspicious black community Their newly discovered commitment to civil rights contributed to the success of the city s sanitation workers strike of 1968 Dr Martin Luther King Jr s death during the strike resonated so deeply that for many of these women it became a defining moment In the long term these women proved to be a persistent and progressive influence upon the attitudes of the white population of Memphis and particularly on the city s elite
