The theory s predictions are empirically tested in a multi method research design that combines statistical analyses and case studies drawing on the original Dictator's Endgame Dataset of all 40 endgames that took place between 1946 and 2014 The study identifies the conditions and processes through which militaries determine the outcome of dictators endgames and thus affect the survival and future political development
