

at the war s end but returned to Japan after relations between China and Japan were normalized in 1972 The memories of Chinese who lived the age of empire in Manchuria make up the fourth map This map also includes the memories of Chinese couples who adopted the abandoned children of Japanese settlers as well as the children themselves who renounced their Japanese nationality and chose to remain in China In the final chapter Tamanoi considers theoretical questions of the state and the relationship between place voice and nostalgia She also attempts to integrate the four memory maps in the transnational space covering Japan and China Both fastidious in dealing with theoretical questions and engagingly written Memory Maps contributes not only to the empirical study of the Japanese empire and its effects on the daily lives of Japanese and Chinese but also to postcolonial theory as it applies to the use of memory
