Shakespearean comedies are plays of Shakespeare that end in marriages or reunions

Generally have a happy ending

Tend to focus more on situations than characters

May involve common-born or middle-class main characters

Elements: the theme of love and marriage, complex plot, mistaken identities or misconceptions, and clever wordplay

SHAKESPEAREAN TRAGEDY

Shakespearean tragedies are plays of Shakespeare that usually end in the death of the tragic hero

Have a sad ending

Tend to focus more characters

Main characters are noblemen, with wealth and power

Elements: tragic heroes, a dichotomy of good and evil, hamartia, issues of fate or fortune, foul revenge, supernatural elements, and catharsis
