
Why?

Why aren't we up to our necks in poop? Why is there always a supply of water? Why is there oxygen to breathe and carbon dioxide for photosynthesis? Organic compounds in nature are also recycled. This recycling process converts the complex organic compounds to simple, inorganic compounds,

which then can be returned to the nutrient cycle and be used in nature again and again.
